Alabama was the site of many of the most important events of the Civil Rights Movement. The Montgomery Bus Boycott begun by Rosa Parks sparked changes. The Children's March in 1963 in Birmingham brought about the Civil Rights Act of 1964. After "Bloody Sunday" and the Voting Rights March from Selma to Montgomery, we got the Voting Rights Act of 1965. On this tour you will not only walk in the footsteps of those courageous people who were part of the Movement, but you will also meet some of them and hear their stories first hand.
